All rooms are single with private bathrooms arranged into flats, with 5 – 8 rooms per flat. Each flat shares a common room/kitchen (kitchens not to be used for cooking).

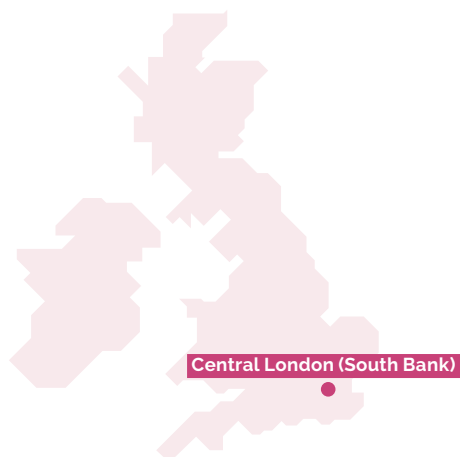
Please note a deposit of £50 per student is required on arrival, in case of damages.
