### Experience London

The Experience London programme is aimed at teenagers and combines 15 hours of English lessons each week with day time activities, excursions, plus some evening activities.

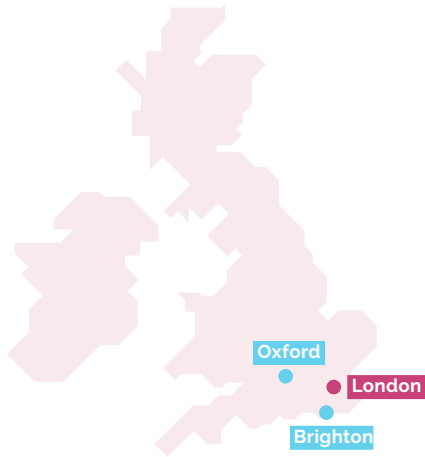
### Meal Plan
