



## St Mary's School Ascot, UK

Our Ascot Residential Summer Centre is based at St Mary's School. This traditional English boarding school was built in the 19th century and has grown into one of the finest boarding schools in the country. Set in 55 acres of beautiful grounds in the heart of Berkshire, with excellent boarding facilities, sports and performing arts facilities, the school is conveniently located in the little town of Ascot, a short journey away from Heathrow airport, Windsor Castle and 25 miles west of London.

## On-campus residential accommodation

Limited modern single en-suite accommodation available at a supplement (requires pre-booking)

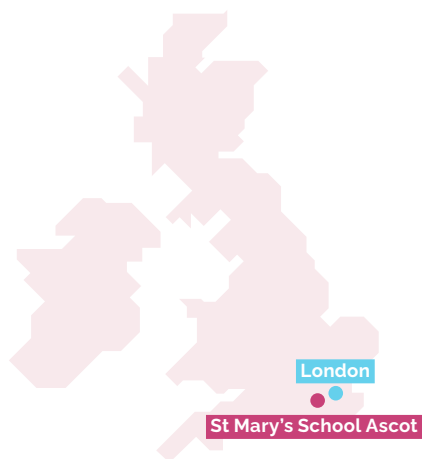
The student:bathroom ratio is between 4:1 & 6:1 and each room has a sink;

boys and girls are housed in different accommodation areas and each area is

supervised by Kings residential staff. Please note a deposit of £50 per student is required on arrival, in case of damages. Towels are not included.

## Meal plan

Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day. Lunch and dinner are usually hot (with packed lunches or preloaded cash cards on excursion days) and there is usually a choice of at least two main courses. We can cater for vegetarian and other dietary requirements on request.
