On-campus residential accommodation

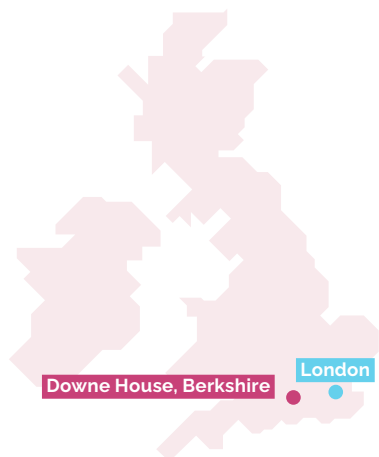
Stunning modernised residential boarding houses each with twin, triple and quad rooms (few singles) with shared bathrooms on a ratio of 1:4.
