## Accommodation

### David Bomberg and McLaren House

David Bomberg and McLaren House are 5 minutes' walk away from the main campus. All rooms are single with private bathrooms arranged into flats, with 5 – 8 rooms per flat. Each flat shares a common room/kitchen (kitchens not to be used for cooking).

Please note a deposit of £50 per student is required on arrival, in case of damages. Lost keys can be charged up to £180. Towels are not included.

### Meal plan

Breakfast, lunch and dinner every day\*. Lunch and dinner are usually hot (with packed lunches or a cash card on full-day excursions) and there is usually a choice of at least two main courses. We can cater for vegetarian and other dietary requirements on request.
